



AUCTION RULES



All of our donors have been very generous — to show our appreciation and respect, please use all items, vacation homes, etc., no later than March 7, 2021 unless otherwise specified. Thank you for understanding. Substitutions are not available.

Registration: All guests must check in upon arrival to receive their registered bid number. Only bids made by registered users will be honored. When bidding for any item, you agree to pay the amount bid if it is determined to be the successful bid.

Live Auction: The auctioneer and his assistants determine the successful bidder for every item sold in the live auction. To bid during the live auction, hold your bid card high until the auctioneer acknowledges your bid.

End of Evening Raffle: The winning ticket will be picked at 9:00 pm during the live auction. Winner does not need to be present to win.

Payment and Item Removal: Before going to the cashier, obtain a computerized list of your successful bids and other purchases made during the evening. With printouts in hand, proceed to the cashier for payment. Payment by cash, personal check, Visa, American Express, MasterCard or Discover Card. Payment must be made in full on the night of the auction. Upon receiving your paid receipt, go to item pick up where a volunteer will greet you. Our volunteer will borrow your receipt and retrieve your purchases for you. Please do not go directly to the display tables to retrieve your purchases. A PAID receipt is required before any item may be taken from the auction site.

For security reasons, all auction purchases must be moved from the premises immediately following the event. Exceptions can be made for items too large to remove on auction night. In this case, purchasers may make arrangements after the auction by emailing auction@stclarepdx.org.

Please pick-up all items no later than March 22, 2020.

Pick up times will be determined and notification will be sent via email. Bring your paid receipt when picking up items.







COLLAGRAPH CITY

First Grade Art

collagraph printing

First graders have been studying the built environment. We recently completed a project in which we illustrated our own neighborhoods from a bird's-eye view. Before making this collagraph print, we studied the illustrations of the contemporary artist James Gulliver Hancock, who has a blog dedicated to drawing all of the buildings in New York. We looked at many of his drawings and noticed the different

types of building shapes, roofs, doors, windows and decorations. First graders then worked on their own building design, first drawing them out on paper, then cutting them out of foam. The unique multi-layered printing plate is called a collagraph.

Our collagraph plates were tiled together as one collaborative artwork.

On "printing day" each

student had a hand in inking the plates and pressing the paper to create the print. We pulled the final print together as a class. It was wonderful to see the students delight in creating a large artwork as a class community.

CYANOTYPE QUILT

Kindergarten Art

Kindergarteners studied cyanotypes, one of the oldest forms of photography. They also learned about the artist Andy Goldsworthy, who creates art using only natural objects such as leaves, flowers, stones, sticks, water and ice. They used pressed flowers and leaves to make a composition on a piece of fabric that had been treated with the special cyanotype substance to make it sensitive to light. We left our compositions in the art room near the windows for 24 hours to expose. We removed the flowers and leaves, rinsed the fabric, and the image appeared like magic. Any part that was covered by a plant or flower was left unexposed and white. Everything else turned a brilliant Prussian blue. The wonderful Susan Humm, grandmother to Charlotte (K), Keagan (2) and Connor (3), sewed and quilted our cyanotype fabric into this beautiful quilt.
